NOAC 2012

The National Order of the Arrow Conference (NOAC) is one of the finest events in which an Arrowman can participate. He will spend a week immersed in an environment focused on the best that Scouting and the Order of the Arrow has to offer.



Scouts who attend NOAC get a chance to meet and interact with other Scouts from across the country, and to work with great adult advisors. The Conference, held on the campus of Michigan State University, provides a safe and healthy environment for a young man to learn about leadership, brotherhood, and service, in an atmosphere of fun and excitement.

Activities include SCUBA, rock climbing, kayaking, Lodge competitions such as dodge ball, ultimate Frisbee and capture the flag. Dance and Drum team competitions are also a highlight of the week. Nightly shows are entertaining for Scouts of all ages. Fellowship, friendship and patch trading are also major components of the week.

Kittan Lodge of the Twin Rivers Council will be sending a contingent of 28 Arrowmen to Michigan State University for NOAC 2012. Lodge travel plans are not finalized; most likely we will travel by plane.

Qualification: NOAC is open to all Arrowmen who are actively registered within their Lodge. Availability is on a "first come - first served" basis. Space is limited so sign up now! Kittan Lodge will give preference to youth Arrowmen.



The anticipated attendance is over 8,000 and you will have the opportunity to meet and interact with other Arrowmen from lodges across the country and around the world.



Cost: The NOAC fee will include: conference fee, all transportation, meals, lodging and insurance. The anticipated cost for NOAC 2012 is approximately \$900 per Scout. A deposit of \$150 must accompany the official application. Scouts will require a current Class III Medical Form. Participants will have the opportunity to work on fundraisers, such as popcorn sales and car washes, to help defray the cost of this experience.



While attending NOAC Scouts stay in college dorm rooms and eat in the cafeteria. The food is excellent and plentiful.
